### 2010 Academic Scholarship Program Application Instructions

#### QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Applicant must be a high school student who is eligible for graduation, June 2010.
2. Applicant must be an eligible Gold or Silver member in good standing on the JAGS Junior Tour and complete a minimum of 5 JAGS Junior Tour tournaments during the 2009/2010 tournament season, including 1 major tournament.
3. Applicant must have a 3.0 or higher grade point average with first semester grades on file with JAGS Junior Tour by the required reporting deadline and submit final grades on or before July 1, 2010.
4. Applicant should have demonstrated outstanding academic effort during high school.
5. Applicant should have been active in school activities, leadership programs and service to their community.
6. Applicant must enroll in an accredited Vocational or Technical School, Community College, 4 Year College or University the following fall after graduation from High School.

#### APPLICATION:

1. Applicant must submit a completed typed application.
2. Applicant must include a sealed copy of their school transcript showing academic grade point average through February, 2010 to include the first semester of their Senior year.
3. Applicant must obtain **TWO sealed** letters of recommendations from non-family members.
4. Applicant is required to write an **ESSAY of no less than 2 pages** typed and double spaced.

**Topic: "Who in your life has been your biggest influence and why?"**

5. Mail your completed application form with your sealed official transcript, the required letters of recommendations and an original color picture (Senior picture or an individual golf picture) to:

*Applications will not be accepted if postmarked earlier than April 1, 2010 or after April 30, 2010. Applications that are faxed or hand delivered will not be considered.*

**SELECTION PROCESS:** Each application will be reviewed and judged by the Academic Scholarship Committee for consideration. High school athletic accomplishments and potential participation in athletics at college is not a consideration for this award. This award is solely based on high school achievements in academics, school clubs and activities, leadership programs, and service to their community. Scholarship recipient(s) will be announced by June 30, 2010. The actual scholarship award will be presented to the recipient(s) in early August at the JAGS Annual Players Awards Banquet after the completion of the 2009/2010 season.
