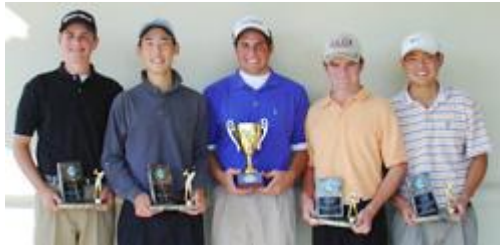

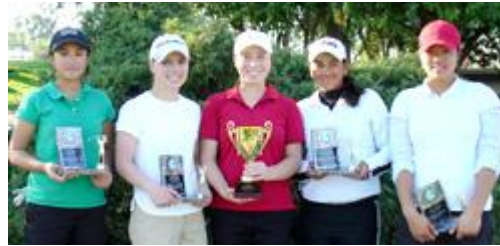

### RONNALD MONACO AND JOY TROTTER EARN AJGA EXEMPTIONS WITH VICTORIES AT THE PRESIDENT'S CUP

Chino Hills, California, **Junior Amateur Golf Scholars (JAGS)** conducted its 6<sup>th</sup> annual President's Junior Cup at the demanding Los Serrano's North course in Chino Hills, California. This redesigned and re-rated course provides a challenge for players due to its hilly terrain, undulating greens, and narrow fairways lined with mature trees. Day one brought wet and soggy condition with 4" of rain the night before and a sudden 20 minute downpour at tee off time Sunday morning. Players battled early morning cold, rain and winds during the round making scoring conditions very difficult.

Ronnald Monaco from Rancho Cucamonga, Calif., was tied for tenth after round one posting a 3-over 75, three shot behind leaders, Kenny Roberts, Seal Beach, Calif., and Tain Lee, San Juan Capistrano, Calif., who scored even par, 72. Skyler Hong, San Diego, Calif., was in third at 73, and a log jam of six players, Miles Cole, Los Alamitos, Calif., Scott Clayton, San Bernardino, Calif., Michael Jae Woo Im, Fullerton, Calif., James Moseley, Arcadia, Calif., Bryan Taylor, San Juan Capistrano, Calif., and Mark Alvarez, Pomona, Calif., all tied for fourth at 74. In the Girls division, day one low score was posted by leader MacKinzie Kline, Encinitas, CA at 2-under 72 with Joy Trotter, Chino Hills, Calif., and Lee Lopez, Whittier, Calif., each scoring even par, 74 tied for second. Rounding at the top five during round one was Nara Kim, Diamond Bar, Calif., 77 and Kristen Park, Buena Park, Calif., at 78.

Round two had a frost delay of one hour with players eagerly waiting to start their rounds. Ronnald Monaco playing in the third group behind the leaders posted a strong front nine with an eagle on the par 5 third hole, then doubled the next and then scored two birdies on hole seven and nine for a 2-under 34. He continued his solid play on the back nine with 8 pars and 1 birdie to complete his round at 3-under 69 to claim the victory. Monaco said, "I knew the wet conditions could cause the scores to be high on day one, so I figured if I could keep my score close to par and do my best to go low on the final round, I might have a chance to win or tie and force a play-off. This is a very strong field of players and anyone could go low and win the tournament. I had to avoid big numbers by concentrating on hitting fairways and greens for a chance to win." This is Monaco's second JAGS victory with his first coming at the Shandin Hills Shootout in January, 2005. Cole made a charge on the leaders and posted a 1-under 71 for his final round which put him in a tie for second scoring 74-71-145 with Lee who posted a 1-over 73 on his final round. Clayton completed round two with 74-72-146 for 4<sup>th</sup> place and Im placed 5<sup>th</sup> with a 74-73-147. There was a five-way tie for 6<sup>th</sup> place at 148 with Daniel Watase, Thousand Oaks, Calif., Matthew J. Stratton, Littleton, CO, Matthew Ouimet, Coto de Caza, Calif., Ryan Chan, Carson, Calif., and Skyler Hong, San Diego, Calif. Additionally, Monaco's victory earned him an exemption to a future AJGA open tournament.

Joy Trotter, Chino Hills, Calif., shot the low round on day two of the tournament with a 2-under 72 to finish with a two day total of 74-72-146, 2-under par taking home her first JAGS' victory along with an exemption to a future AJGA open

tournament. After waiting an extra hour to tee off due to the frost delay, Trotter, Kline, Lopez and Kim were excited to be in the final group for a chance to go head to head for the championship. Kline held a slim lead on the field after the front nine by scoring a 1-under 35 to Lopez's 2-under 34, Trotter's 1-over 37 and Kim's 4-over 40. The back nine proved to be the difference as Trotter seemed to be in a zone scoring birdies on holes 13, 15 and 18 to win by one stroke over Kline who posted 72-75-147, 1-under par for the tournament. Trotter said, "I really had to focus on all my shots because of the wet conditions and the strong competitors in the field. It is great when everything goes right. My hard work has paid off and I am so proud to be the JAGS Girl's Champion and earn an AJGA exemption."

Kline finished second at 147, Lopez took third with a 150, Kim placed fourth with a 155 and Veronica Valerio, Temecula, Calif., took fifth with a 156. Rounding out the top ten were, Stephanie Hu, Cerritos, Calif., sixth at 157, Park seventh with a 158, Blair Lewis, La Mesa, Calif., eighth with a 159, Jamie Yam, San Diego, Calif., ninth with a 161 and Demi Frances Runas, Torrance, Calif., finished tenth with a 162.

JAGS is a 501(c) 3 non-profit for public benefit organization hosting monthly 36-hole nationally ranked junior tournaments for boys and girls age 12-18 years old.

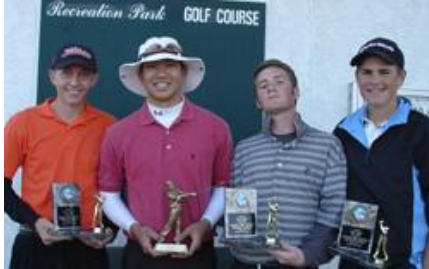

Rancho Santa Margarita, Calif., playing the from the tips at the ever challenging Tijeras Creek Golf Club, Tom Moore, junior at Edison High School, Huntington Beach, Calif., finished with even par 72 to capture his first JAGS title by 1 stroke over Michael Drake, senior at Martin Luther King Jr. High School, Riverside in the 2006 Southern California Boys Junior Championship.

Moore's front nine was solid with birdies on holes 1, 4 and the 5<sup>th</sup>, a par-three signature hole where he sunk a 35 foot downhill birdie to go 3-under. ### WONG BIRDIES FOR WIN - RUNAS TOO HOT FOR FIELD

Rancho Santa Margarita, California, **JAGS Junior Tour (Junior Amateur Golf Scholars)** conducted its 6<sup>TH</sup> annual Marty LaRoche Junior Cup tournament at the challenging Tijeras Creek Golf Course in Rancho Santa Margarita, California on June 28-29, 2006. This 36-hole event is nationally ranked by Junior Golf Scoreboard.

It's summer time in California! June gloom was gone with temperatures soaring over the 100 degree mark and a late afternoon shotgun start, tested not only the players golfing skills but their physical conditioning too. Players saw the course from a different perspective this year as the boys competed from the demanding black tees (6,918 yds. 73.4/136) and the girls from ever challenging white tees (6,220 yds. 77.1/138).

Round one in the boys division had many players in a log jam at one or two over par at the end of the day. Sean Harris, Santa Monica, Calif., posted even par 72, to lead by two shots over Michael Yiu, Laguna Hills, Calif., (74) and three shots over Brendan Wong, Orange, Calif., and international player Matthew Giles, Australia, both at 75. Tom Moore, Huntington Beach, Calif. was four back at 76, and three players five back tied at 77. Harris started on the ninth hole with par and then blazed the back nine scoring at 4-under par (32). Harris said, "I was on fire and could not miss a chip or putt on the back nine but after making the turn, the heat was really getting to me and I simply ran out of energy giving back 4 shots on holes 4, 5, 6 and 7 but managed to par my last two hole to finish at even par."

14 year old Demi Frances Runas, Torrance, Calif., (79) led the girl's field in round one by 1 stroke over Yolanda Lin, Brea, Calif., (80), Lana Cox, San Clemente, Calif., (81) and defending champion Tarah Taylor, Mission Viejo, Calif., who finished at 84. As the heat soared so did the scores. Feeling extremely sick from the heat, Runas was about to withdraw on the 18<sup>th</sup> hole but knew she only had six holes to play and decided to keep going and finish her round. Runas said, "I think I drank too much water trying to stay cool and I did not feel good. All I could think about was doing my best to finish the round so I could get into the air conditioned club house."

Day two began with cooler morning tee times giving players a much needed reprieve from the afternoon heat. Many players came out firing low rounds on the front nine but found temperatures rising and scores climbing on the back nine. First round leader, Harris completed the tournament posting (72-78-150) to tie for fourth place with Scott Clayton, San Bernardino, Calif., who had trouble during round one but played solidly during round two to score (77-73-150). Yiu finished in third place scoring (74-75-149) had solid ball striking off the tee and in the fairways but was unable to convert a few birdie and par putts to make a move for the championship. Defending champion, Giles along with Wong both in the final group of the day went head to head during round two to finish in a tie both posting (75-73-148), 4-over par to force a play-off to determine the winner.

The play-off began on the par-5 hole number one with Wong hitting a beautiful drive dead center in the fairway. Giles up next pushed his drive to the right just over the fairway bunker. As Giles, spectators and officials approached the

area where Giles ball was suppose to be, they saw nothing, no ball in sight. The search was on, but so was the 5-minute clock. As everyone frantically looked for Giles ball, time ran out, forcing him back to the tee to hit his third shot. Wong, knowing he had the advantage, hit his second shot landing it 15 feet from the pin for a chance to make eagle or birdie and the win. Giles on the green lying 4 with a 5 foot par putt, marked his ball and told Wong, go for it, make the putt. Wong missed his eagle putt by a couple of inches, tapped in for birdie and the championship. With the gallery and officials watching, Giles quickly went to Wong shook his hand and gave Wong his congratulations. Wong said, "I wish we could have found Matthew's ball because it would have made the play-off a lot more fun." Wong will be attending Cal-Poly University – SLO in the fall as a freshman and was honored to win his second JAGS title before becoming a collegiate golfer.

In the girls division, Runas kept her game steady and on course to claim her second JAGS title this season by posting rounds of 79-78-157. Runas said, "I only concentrated on fairways and greens today and doing everything possible to stay cool and hydrated. I am so excited to earn my second JAGS win this season." She did just that to claim her victory by 9 stokes over second place finisher Jade Okamoto, Huntington Beach, Calif., and eleven stokes over third place finisher Cox. Lin and Taylor tied for fourth place with Megan Chang, Irvine, Calif., taking fifth.

JAGS would like to thank tournament officials Eve Clayton and Dave Moore for all their help and assistance during the tournament and all the volunteers who help transport players from green to tee on the steep paths on the back nine.

JAGS next two-day tournament will be held at California Country Club in Whittier, California on July 20-21, 2006. This event is in honor of JAGS Junior Tour founder Cindy Warren's grandparents, Jack and Madaline Hooper who were avid golfers and huge supporters of junior golf. This 36-hole tournament is nationally ranked by Junior Golf Scoreboard and the results are watched by National and Regional junior golf programs, and college coaches throughout the US. Players need not be members of JAGS to participate, although member's tournament fees are lower.

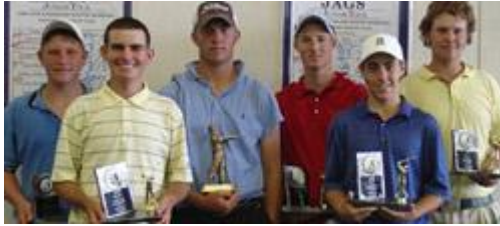

### GEIS TAKES CHAMPIONSHIP IN A 3-HOLE PLAY-OFF PICCIO POST 2-UNDER TO CAPTURE FIRST JAGS VICTORY

Whittier, California, **JAGS (Junior Amateur Golf Scholars)** conducted its 6<sup>TH</sup> annual Jack and Madaline Hooper Memorial at California Country Club in Whittier, California on June 20-21, 2006. The summer heat and unusual high humidity was in full force as players teed it up on this tight course with narrow fairways lined with mature trees.

Dan Geis, El Segundo, Calif., went wire to wire in the boys division to claim his second JAGS title this season. Scoring 1-under par during round one gave Geis a one stroke advantage going into round two over Russell Boring, Westlake Village, Calif., (72) and two strokes ahead of Spencer Montgomery, Bolder City, Nevada (73), and Brandon Van Goethen, Huntington Beach, Calif., (73). Geis said, "It is always great to post under-par in round one, but I know the strong players that are one or two strokes behind me have game and I must play solid tomorrow for me to have a chance to win this tournament." The girls division day one leader, Alice Kim, Diamond Bar, Calif., blazed the course during her round as she posted 4-under (70) giving her a 5-stroke lead over Maria Imelda T. Piccio from the Philippines who posted a 1-over (75). Kim said, "Today was really a great round of golf for me. My game was really on target, especially my short game."

Day two brought high expectations from players to go low but the extreme heat and high humidity was a definite factor in the final scores. Geis, Boring, Van Goethen, and Montgomery grouped together were all within one stroke of each other at the turn. Geis and Boring each were 1-over par (37), Montgomery gained a stroke by posting even-par (36) and Van Goethen dropped a stroke posted 2-over par (38) Geis took advantage of Montgomery's double-bogey on the 10<sup>th</sup> hole as he made par to retake the lead. But with Montgomery not giving up, he managed his game to finished at 1-over par (73) forcing a play-off with Geis who found his putter going cold on the final holes posting a 3-over (75). A play-off began on hole number one, a 506 yd. par-5. Montgomery drove his ball to the perfect position while Geis sent his right in front of a sand trap. Both players were short on their second shots but managed to get up and down for par to carry it over to hole two. A par-3 141 yd. hole surrounded by sand traps. Geis had a double-bogey earlier in the day which made him really evaluate his club selection prior to teeing up. Montgomery had birdied and par the hole during the tournament and but found his tee shot drifting straight into the left bunker. With Geis safely on the green and knowing Geis would get down in two, Montgomery had to make a great shot out of the sand to try to force the play-off to the next hole. Montgomery made an incredible sand shot putting his ball 1 foot from the hole to save par. Geis just missed his birdie putt, tapped in for par setting the stage for hole number 3. Montgomery hit a perfect shot down the right hand side in the fairway with an opportunity to chip and putt for birdie. Geis drove his ball over the green on this short par-4 hole looking at a very difficult chip with the green running down hill. Montgomery chip shot landed 7 feet past the hole as Geis' hit his shot perfectly utilizing the down hill slope on the green to gently roll his ball 3 feet right of the pin. Montgomery made an excellent putt just edging the cup for his birdie attempt and putted out for par. Geis stroked his ball to the center of the cup to claim the victory. Montgomery said, "This was my first JAGS Junior Tour tournament. I had never played this course before an am extremely proud to take 2<sup>nd</sup> place in this tournament." Geis said, "Flying the green on my tee shot was not my intent, and having to chip the ball so it would land softly allowing it to trickle down to the hole was key. Spencer is a great golfer and I look forward to playing with him again in the future on the JAGS Junior Tour. I am honored to win this tournament and claim my 2<sup>nd</sup> JAGS title this

season.” Van Goethen placed 3<sup>rd</sup> (73-76-149), Tom Moore, Huntington Beach, Calif., took 4<sup>th</sup> (77-73-150) and Kenny Roberts, Seal Beach, Calif., and Craig Wolfman, Manhattan Beach, Calif., tied for 5<sup>th</sup>. Longest drive was won by Jarred Mondonedo, Rancho Palos Verdes, Calif., and Van Goethen took closest to the pin honors.

The final round in the girls division saw Kim played steady on her first nine holes but found trouble on the back scoring (38-41-79) three strokes out of the lead. Piccio finished 2-under par (75-71-146) to claim her first JAGS Junior Tour victory. Piccio said, “Scoring 2-under on the back nine with two birdies and the rest pars gave me a lot of confidence in my game. I am honored to be the champion and look forward to defending my title next year.” Kim claimed 2<sup>nd</sup> place and Lady Jasmin Samson, Santa Clarita, Calif., took 3<sup>rd</sup> posting 156. Marissa Steiner, Rancho Palos Verdes, Calif., and Megan Chang, Irvine, Calif., placed 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> respectively. Kim won the longest drive contest and Yolanda Lin, Brea, Calif., took closest to the pin honors.

Corona, California, **JAGS** (Junior Amateur Golf Scholars) conducted its final tournament of the 2005/06 season at Cresta Verde Golf Club, Corona, California. A 2002 Jay Miller remodel of a 1927 Randolph Scott designed course was mastered by JAGS' players during the 2006 Toledo Junior Cup on August 2-3, 2006.

Round one had Dan Geis, El Segundo, Calif., carding even par (70) giving him the lead by one shot over Kenny Roberts, Seal Beach, Scott Clayton, San Bernardino, Calif., Adam Michel, Orinda, Calif., and Perrie Garcia, Eagle Rock, Calif., all posting one-over-par (71). Tom Moore, Huntington Beach, Calif., was 5 shots back at (75) and Miles Cole, Los Alamitos, Calif., was seven back at (77). Geis said, "I learned a lot about the course today and tomorrow I am going to change my game plan by putting my driver away and use my irons off the tee. The guys who are right behind me are strong competitors, so it will be important for me to play smart and solid tomorrow." Newcomer, Rebecca Song, Fullerton, Calif., a seasoned junior golfer took a commanding lead in the girls division by scoring even par (72), four shots ahead of fellow competitor, Alice Kim, Diamond Bar, Calif., (76) and five ahead of Maria Imelda T. Piccio, Philippines, Demi Frances Runas, Torrance, Calif., and Flora Weeks, Seattle, Washington, all three scoring (77). Song said, "My game really come together today but I have to play strong tomorrow because the girls behind me have the ability to go low and wipe out my lead."

Birdie, birdie, and more birdies were being circled on many score cards during round two, including first round leader, Geis. Austen Dailey, Westminster, Calif., carded six birdies on his round to score a 4-under (66) which sent him up the leader board into a tie for 5<sup>th</sup> place with Moore who carded even-par (70) during his round. Michel, also posted a solid round of even-par (70) giving him a 4<sup>th</sup> place finish. Clayton, scoring 1-under par (69) put him in third place for his final JAGS tournament before going off to play on the Men's Golf Team at UC Riverside in September. Roberts also had a solid showing by carding a 3-under (67) taking second alone for his final JAGS tournament before joining the Men's Golf Team at Cypress College later this month. At the end of the day, the tournament belonged to Geis alone, as he posted the lowest round of the day (65) and the lowest two-day total in the JAGS Junior Tour history by scoring 5-under (135). Geis said, "I executed my game plan perfectly and used my long irons off the tee which put my ball into scoring position on every hole. Today was so much fun, and playing with these outstanding golfers made it the best round ever. I am so honored to win back to back JAGS titles especially with this strong competitive field. This is one round of golf I will never forget."

The girls continued to battle during the second round. Staying patient and hitting fairways and greens allowed Piccio to move into a tie with Song at the end of round two. Song struggled during her round posting a 6-over (78). Piccio completed her round by scoring a 1-over par (73) forcing a play-off with Song. Teeing it up on hole 10, a 510 yd. par

5 hole for the play-off saw both Song and Piccio placing their balls left side of the fairway in perfect position. Their second shots each landed just short of the elevated green on the right side in the fairway for a chance to chip it close and make birdie. Piccio was away with a down hill putt approximately 15 feet from the pin. She stroked the ball solid but her birdie putt broke slightly left when it reached the hole just missing by inches. Song, 10 feet from the hole with an up hill putt, drained it into the center of the cup to claim her first JAGS victory. Piccio said, "Playing on the JAGS Junior Tour is something I look forward to each summer before going back to school in the Phillipines. I am honored to have placed first and second in the two JAGS tournaments I played in this year." Song, a new comer to the JAGS Junior Tour, was excited to win the play-off and her first JAGS title. Song said, "I really had a hard time today during regular play. I didn't hit many fairways and my putts would not drop. I am so glad my birdie putt went in on the first play-off hole allowing me to win the tournament. I hope to play in more JAGS tournaments next season." Rounding off the top five finishers were, Runas in 3<sup>rd</sup>, Kim placed 4<sup>th</sup> and Michele Chun, Chino Hills, Calif., taking 5<sup>th</sup>.
